According to the decision taken at the Senate meeting dated 10.07.2024 and numbered 22/01, students must fulfill the following requirements in order to be eligible for their thesis defense examination:

Master's Program*

- At least one (1) article produced from the thesis work, in which the student is the first author or corresponding author, accepted for publication in a journal indexed in TR Dizin, Scopus, or a higher-level index;

OR

- At least one (1) national or international conference paper, presented orally and published in full-text format.

*This requirement applies to students who enrolled in the Fall semester of the 2024–2025 academic year.

Ph.D. / Integrated Ph.D. Program

- Acceptance of at least one (1) article produced from the thesis work, for which the student is the first author or corresponding author, in journals indexed by one of the following:
 - SCI (Science Citation Index),
 - SCI-Expanded (Science Citation Index Expanded),
 - SSCI (Social Sciences Citation Index),
 - AHCI (Arts and Humanities Citation Index),
 - AVERY (Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals),
 - DAAI (Design and Applied Arts Index),
 - Art Index (Art Research Database, EBSCO),
 - ICONDA (International Construction Database),
 - ESCI (Emerging Sources Citation Index).
- At least one (1) national or international conference paper, presented orally and published as a full-text proceeding.
- Participation in at least one (1) event involving collaboration with the private sector, public institutions, or NGOs (e.g., consultancy, workshop, seminar, symposium, etc.).
