

### **Double Major Program Application Requirements**

- 1-Application requirements and required documents for double major programs are announced by Student Affairs.
- 2-Applications are performed until the deadline specified in academic calender to Student Affairs.
- 3- A student can apply more than one double major or/and minor programs by specifying preference placement.
- 4- Below requirements should be satisfied in order the student's application to be valid.
  - a) All the grades of the courses taken until application semester should be at least C or S and the cGPA should be at least 3,20,
  - b) Student's success rating in his/her registered class should be at least within the top 20%, and those who don't satisfy this requirement, should hold a Central Placement point not less than the double major program's base point in related year.
  - c) Student should be in the 3rd semester earliest and in the 5th semester latest in his registered undergraduate major program.
  - d) Additional conditions may be determined by the related department's offer and board decision and specified in the announcement.
- 5- Withdrawn courses (W grade) are considered as "not taken" in the evaluation process.

### **Minor Program Application Requirements**

- 1- Application requirements and required documents for minor programs are announced by Student Affairs.
- 2- Applications are performed until the deadline specified in academic calender to Student Affairs.
- 3- A student can apply more than one double major or/and minor programs by specifying preference placement.
- 4- Below requirements should be satisfied in order the student's application to be valid.
  - a) Student should be succesfull of all the courses taken in Major program and the cGPA should be at least 2,75,
  - b) Student should be in the 3rd semester earliest and in the 6th semester latest in his registered major undergraduate program.
  - d) Additional conditions may be determined by the related department's offer and board decision and specified in the announcement.
- 5- Withdrawn courses (W grade) are considered as "not taken" in the evaluation process.
