

Application Requirements

For inter-institutional lateral transfers

(1) Students are required to meet the following requirements to be eligible to apply under this category.

a) At the time of application, having registration in an equivalent program or being on leave (with student status).

b) Having completed at least two semesters in the currently registered program (excepting English Preparatory Class).

c) Having taken all the courses in the program curricula for the semesters finished and passing them with D/S grades or their equivalents. Applications of students who have not taken all the curriculum courses for the semesters studied or have failed a course (with F, NA, U, I, W grades or their equivalents) are not evaluated.

d) Having a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00 out of 4.

For internal transfers within the institution

(1) Students are required to meet the following requirements to be eligible to apply under this category.

a) At the time of application, having registration in an equivalent program or being on leave (with student status).

b) Having completed at least two semesters in the currently registered program (excepting English Preparatory Class).

c) Having taken all the courses in the program curricula for the semesters finished and passing them with D/S grades or their equivalents. Applications of students who have not taken all the curriculum courses for the semesters studied or have failed a course (with F, NA, U, I, W grades or their equivalents) are not evaluated.

d) Having a cumulative GPA of at least 2.30 out of 4.

For international transfers

(1) To be eligible to apply under this category, students are required to meet the requirements for the inter-institutional lateral transfers in addition to the conditions set in the AGU Directive for Acceptance of International Students into Undergraduate Degrees.

For Transfers with Central Placement Scores

(1) Students' central placement scores taken in the year when they enrolled at the their current higher education institutions are used. To be eligible to apply under this category, these scores are required to be equivalent to or higher than the minimum score of the same year accepted in the program to be transferred to.

(2) Only preparatory year or first year students transferring with their central placement scores are accepted into the School of Languages if they cannot document their English proficiency. Other candidates are asked to document their English proficiency with one of the exam results determined by the University Senate.

For Transfers with Additional Article-2

Applications are done according to the “Directive Regarding Transfers within Higher Education Institutes for Vocational, Undergraduate and Graduate Programs, Major and Minor Programs and Inter-Institutional Credit Transfer Base.”

Within this scope;

- Turkish citizens studying in vocational, undergraduate and graduate programs in Russian Federation (except speciality in Medicine and Dentistry)
- Turkish citizens and international students studying in Syria and Egypt.
- Turkish citizens studying in Yemen.
- Turkish Citizens studying in Libya
