

## DO YOU NEED TO PROVIDE PROOF OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY?



Because AGU offers all its programs 100% in English, it is important that our students have a sufficient language level to be able to follow and understand their Faculty courses at the University.

**> Undergraduate applicants are exempted from providing proof of their English proficiency if they fulfill one of the following cases:**

1. They are native speakers (having grown up in their homecountry)
2. They grew up in an English-speaking country
3. They completed all their high school years in an English-medium school (please provide proof of your school's language of Instruction)
4. They are applying with two A- or two AS-levels ([see minimum requirements here](#))

**> Students who do not fulfill one of the above-listed exemptions are required to provide proof of English proficiency. In this case, applicants have the following options:**

a) Take the TOEFL exam ([minimum requirements here](#))

b) Take the [AGU IMS English Exemption Exam](#) on campus before the start of the semester. Please note that students who fail the AGU IMS exam will be required to complete our one-year English Preparatory Program at the [AGU School of Languages](#) before starting their Faculty courses.

*Please note that we can **no longer accept the IELTS exam** as proof of English proficiency due to new regulations for Turkish State universities.*
