Dear AGU Members,

**The Call for Teaching** is now published.

All academic and administrative staff members who wish to participate in Staff Mobility for Teaching must submit their applications through the online portal at <https://turnaportal.ua.gov.tr>. Applications will be accepted between 22 June 2026, 08:30 and 10 July 2026, 17:30.

### IMPORTANT:

- All the academic staff who wish to take part in this mobility program can apply without an acceptance letter. If you are selected as eligible; you must submit your acceptance letter to the Erasmus Office until the date to be determined by the Erasmus Commission. Otherwise, You will lose the right to participate in Erasmus mobility. Instead, the substitutes will get the chance to submit the acceptance letter.
- The academic staff who receive the acceptance letter must take into account the Commission's decision-making process and take the mobility start date to begin on a date after Commission's decision.
- **For teaching mobility, bilateral agreement is required. Please [click here](#) for the list of our bilateral agreements.**
- **You can only apply for one of the Mobility Calls for Staff Teaching and Staff Training.**

#### Green Travel

Green travel refers to **travel conducted using low-carbon-emission public transportation**. Buses, trains, and shared car usage fall within the scope of green travel.

To be eligible for **green travel support**, both **outbound and return journeys must use green travel**, and **more than half of the total journey must be completed using green transportation methods**.

When necessary, for **travel days**, up to **two additional days** of individual support can be granted for standard travel, and up to **six additional days** for green travel, covering both pre- and post-mobility travel periods.

### 4. MOBILITY DURATION

The duration of Erasmus+ mobility may range from 2 days to 2 months. However, grant support is available for a maximum of 7 days. This period consists of up to 5 days of activity and up to 2 travel days.

- Staff members may receive Erasmus+ funding for a maximum of 5 activity days and 2 travel days.
- Staff members undertaking a 5-day activity period may receive funding for up to 2 additional travel days. In this case, the total funded period may not exceed 7 days.
- In order to be eligible for individual support for travel days, the journey must commence at least one day before the start date of the activity, and entry into the country must take place at least one day after the end date of the activity.

### 5. ZERO GRANT MOBILITY

All academic staff members on the **reserve list** may participate in staff mobility **without financial support**.
