Literature/film/architecture/tourist-guides/photographs/city plans -all provide selective representations of the city, and (re)shape the metaphors and narratives which are widely used to describe the experience of urban living. The course responds to the cultural work of representations of urban space of metropolitan cities focusing on the everyday life. Exploring arguments and debates in the context of recent academic researches, this course critically investigates urban and cultural developments in the metropolitan cities, in theory across the built environment disciplines.
