Content	Course aims to discuss the problem of – social, communal, individual – housing in the 20 th century, up to the contemporary period. The historical background goes as far as the beginning of industrialization in England at end of the 17 th century, and discusses designed cities and housing estates of the 18 th -19 th centuries. The 20 th century is inspected in three major periods, between the world wars, post-WWII and post-modern, and concludes with contemporary problems and projects. Other aims include discussing urban development, regeneration and transformation based on the creation of housing estates and settlement areas as well as the sustainability and preservation of important examples.
